

## Tauranga Gliding Club Electronics.

1. Boom Box Bluetooth
2. Big TV wireless connect/network
3. Printer wireless connect/connect
4. Laptop

1. To connect your phone/Laptop/Tablet to the boom box.  
Its an interesting device.  
The buttons are NOT identified or easy to see!  
The power button on/off does NOT reset the device  
It merely proves power!

To rest the bluetooth.

You need to press the button for a few seconds until you hear the drum beat.

Then the Bluetooth light will flash.

NOW you can connect your device to the Boom3.

Note: If you are using Club wifi for your music source. The Club WIFI cuts out regularly and this will disconnect the Boom3 from your music.



2. Big TV. This is a wireless connection – Not Bluetooth  
Can be used to Mirror your phone screen content.  
The TV has a wireless Dongle that connects the TV to the Club Router WIFI

First you need to switch on the TV and make sure the source is HTM3 and get the connect screen(See pic)

To connect your phone. (I am an Android Man-Ask John Roberts for Apple)

To Use the laptop.

Add bluetooth or other device

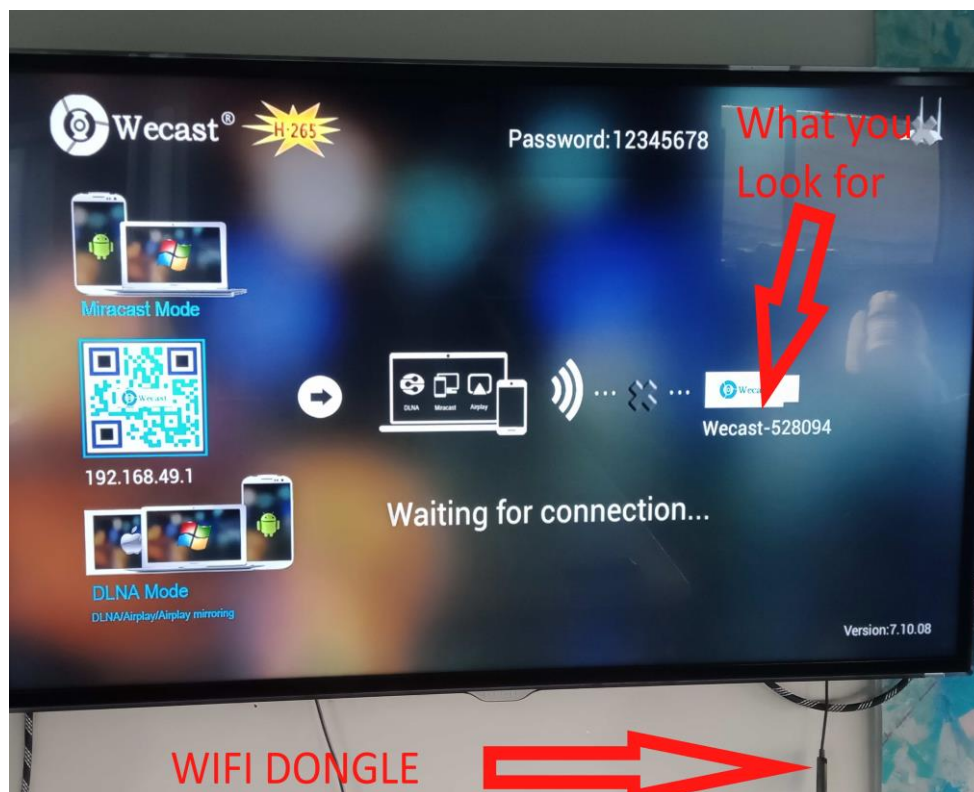
Wireless Display or clock.

To Use a laptop.

Note: It might take a few seconds. To find.
